West Clermont Schools Utilizes Grant to Hire An Elementary School Resource Officer

As West Clermont continues to focus on ensuring the safety and security of its students, staff, and school buildings, the district will utilize a state-level grant to support efforts in this area. The funding from this grant was part of Ohio House Bill 110 and was awarded to West Clermont by the office of Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost.

Ventre is a two-time recipient of the lifesaving award by the Clermont County Chamber of Commerce. He and his wife have four young children—three of which are of elementary age. He assumed his new role as Elementary School SRO on August 15th, 2022.
